Duquesne Light Nonresidential Lighting Program

– Eligibility Information

ELIGIBLE PRODUCTS

Only screw-in lamps included on the ENERGY STAR® qualified product list (QPL) qualify for a rebate through Duquesne Light's Nonresidential Lighting Program. Product eligibility can be confirmed at: energystar.gov/productfinder/product/certified-light-bulbs.

Eligible LED screw-in replacement lamp categories currently include:

- A-Line 40/60W
- A-Line 75/100W
- R20/PAR20
- PAR30
- R30/BR30
- PAR38
- R40/BR40
- PAR16

Downlight Retrofit Kits <25 Watts with a screw-base adapter are also eligible. Product eligibility can be confirmed at energystar.gov/productfinder/product/certified-light-fixtures. Additional lamp categories and technologies may be added in the future as the program, market conditions and ENERGY STAR QPL evolve.

ELIGIBLE CUSTOMERS

Rebates on qualifying ENERGY STAR lamps are available at the point of sale to businesses in Duquesne Light's service territory that receive electrical service under a nonresidential rate class. Residential customers, businesses located outside Duquesne Light's service territory and third-party distributors or retailer outlets are not eligible for the Nonresidential Lighting Program.

PROGRAM RULES

Qualifying lamps must be installed and operated at the eligible customer's facility or premises. Each installation address must be verified in order for distributors to receive a rebate. All lamps must be installed within 30 days; bulb stocking is not allowed.
